In a Notice of Decision filed February 6, 1980, compensation was awarded and is continuing at \$87.50 reduced earnings rate, Claimant classified as permanent partial disability. Case closed.

Claimant's attorney in application filed September 10, 1981 requests the case be reopened contending the claimant is now totally disabled. Dr. S. Reissman in a narrative medical report indicates, "It is my opinion that she has a permanent total disability and cannot be gainfully employed in any capacity and will not improve...".

Examination of the folder discloses a C-250 claim for reimbursement out of 15-8 Special Fund, filed March 2, 1979, the issue has not been resolved to date.

On application of the claimant's attorney and on Motion of the Board this case is reopened and restored to the Trial Calendar solely on questions of worsening of claimant's condition since the closing of the case and claim for reimbursement under Workers' Compensation Law Section 15.8. The Workers' Compensation Law Judge is to decide on the completed record.
